Wednesday 11 AM Concordia band concert here for K-3. Here tonight at 7 PM is

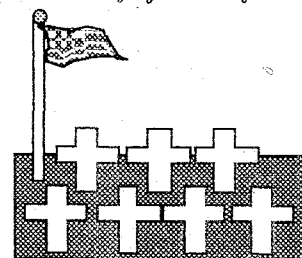
Concordia's Fine Arts Festival in the church. Please come and enjoy.
